



DONATION POLICY

The New to You Bargain Shop helps raise funds for the NCVO—the Cayman Islands’ longest running charitable organisation. Donations don't have to be monetary, in fact, the next time you get in the spring cleaning mood, box up your used items and drop them off at the Bargain Shop.

Items that are sold at minimal cost help to fund key programmes of the organisation. Your unwanted items might help fund a student’s school lunch, a child’s preschool tuition or funding support for a college student.

Not sure what to give? Look at the list below to help you decide whether your items should be donated:

Here are some of the most common items the Bargain Shop must turn away:

- Batteries, electronics and appliances older than five years.
- Furniture with rips, broken pieces, stains, odours or covered in pet hair
- Used undergarments (*Undergarments and bathing suits should only be donated if they are brand new and are still either in their original packaging or with the original tag*)
- Clothing smelling of smoke, or that is stained or damaged.
- Broken/damaged toys.
- Partly used toiletries and toiletries older than six months.

Lightly used items are appreciated including:

- Clothing (washed and sorted)
- Shoes
- Baby items
- Household items
- Working electronics
- Toys
- Books
- Furniture
